

## COVID-19 Summary Report for Marion County

- As of October 25, 2021, Marion County has 960 cases of COVID-19 and 38 confirmed deaths
- There were 5 cases reported from October 15 to October 21
- Marion County accounts for 0.08% of COVID cases in Georgia
- 7% of positive cases in Marion County have been hospitalized and 4% have died
- The average percent of positive PCR tests in Marion County over the last 7 days is 13.6%
- The total number of confirmed cases (PCR) per 100,000 people in Marion County is 7,922.34
- In Marion County, 3,679 (44%) of residents have received at least one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine and 3,236 (38%) have been fully vaccinated

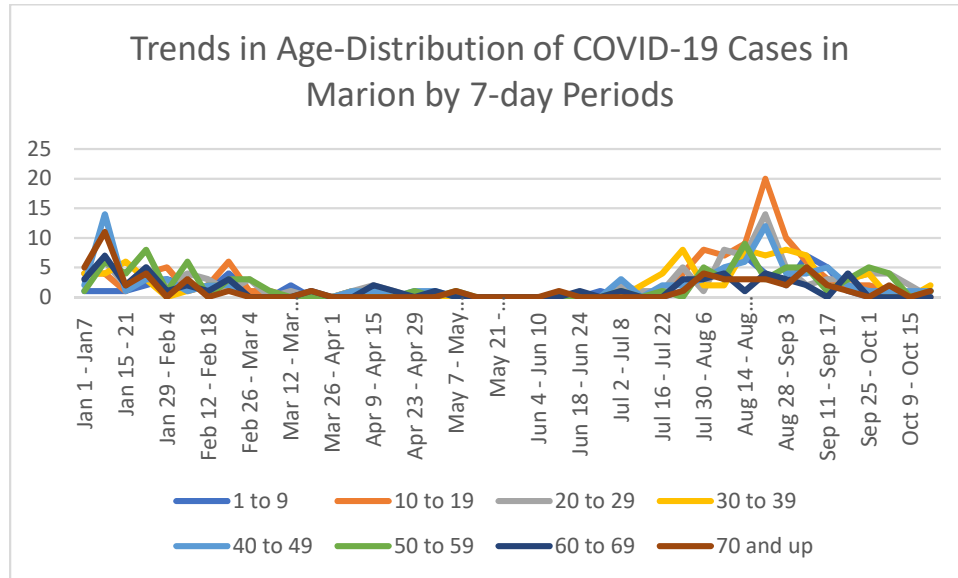

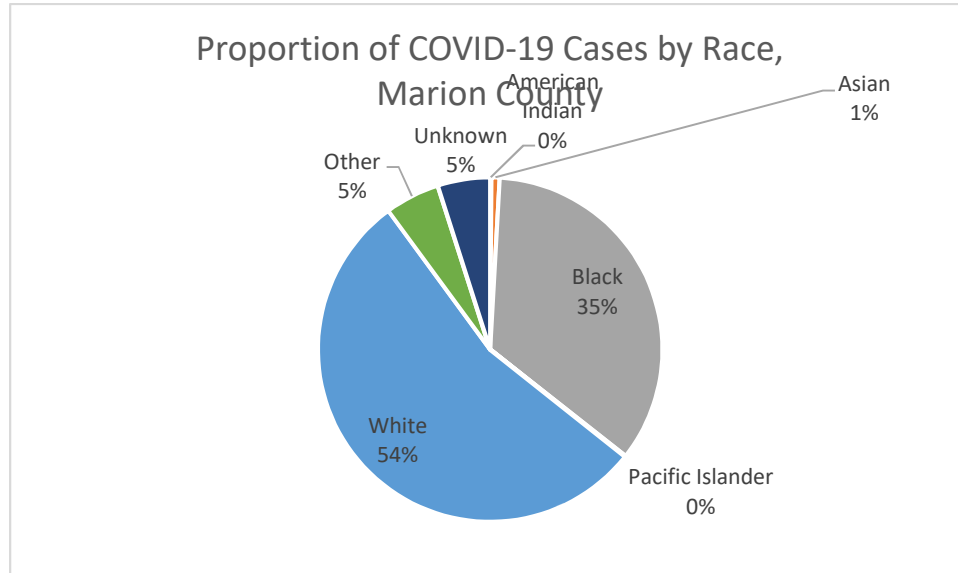

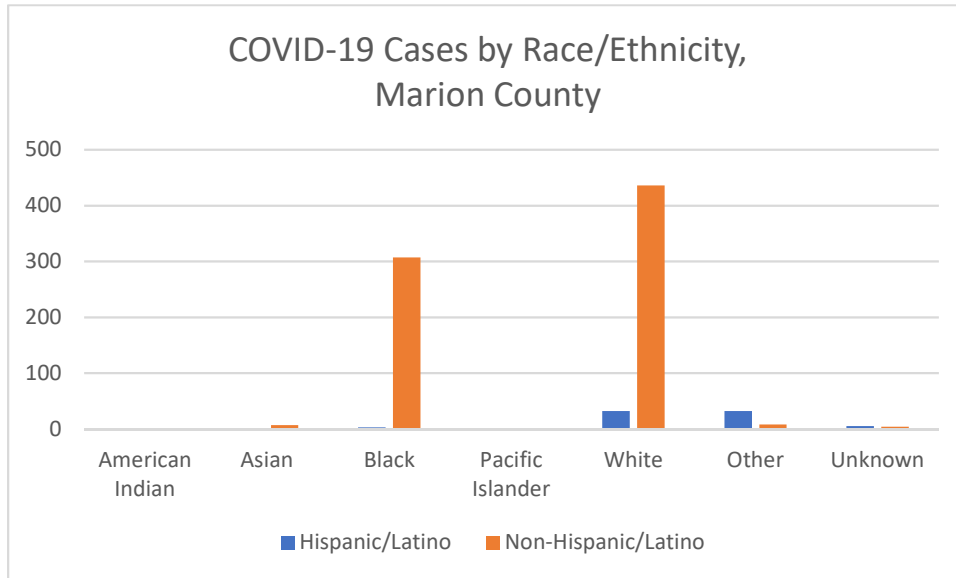
**GRAPH 1. DISTRIBUTION OF POSITIVE CASES BY AGE OVER 7-DAY PERIODS**



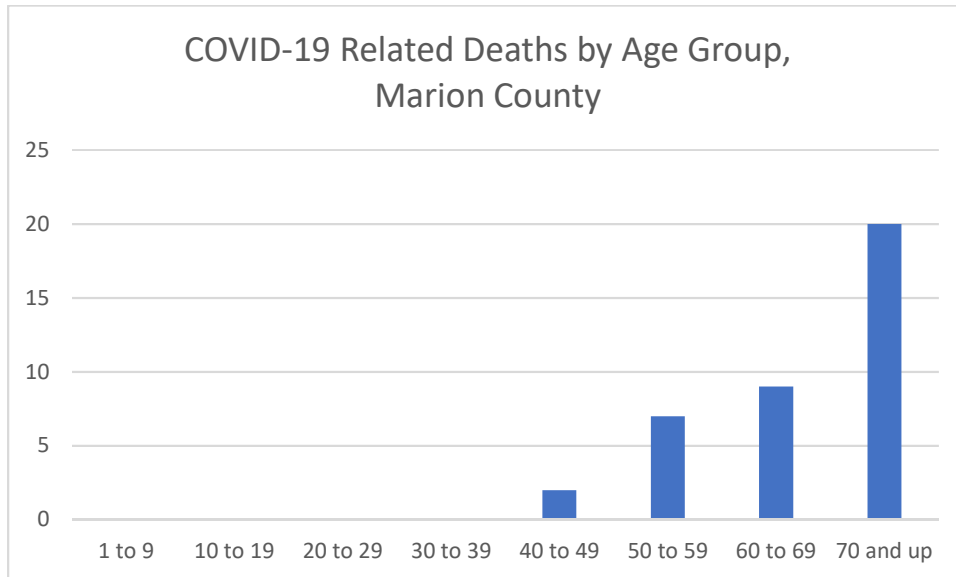
**GRAPH 2. PROPORTION OF COVID-19 CASES IN MARION COUNTY**



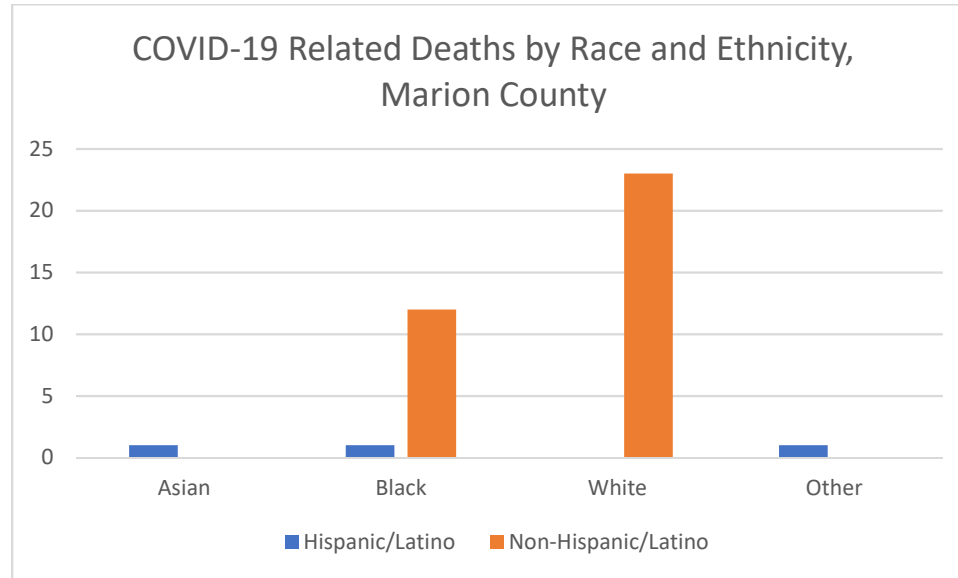
**GRAPH 3. COVID-19 CASES BY RACE AND ETHNICITY IN MARION COUNTY**
