

## COVID-19 Summary Report for Randolph County

- As of October 25, 2021, Randolph County has 997 cases of COVID-19 and 40 confirmed deaths
- There were 7 cases reported from October 15 to October 21
- Randolph County accounts for 0.08% of COVID cases in Georgia
- 10.1% of positive cases in Randolph County have been hospitalized and 4.1% have died
- The average percent of positive PCR tests in Randolph County over the last 7 days is 15.5%
- The total number of confirmed cases (PCR) per 100,000 people in Randolph County is 8,883.62
- In Randolph County, 3,458 (50%) of residents have received at least one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine and 3,075 (44%) have been fully vaccinated

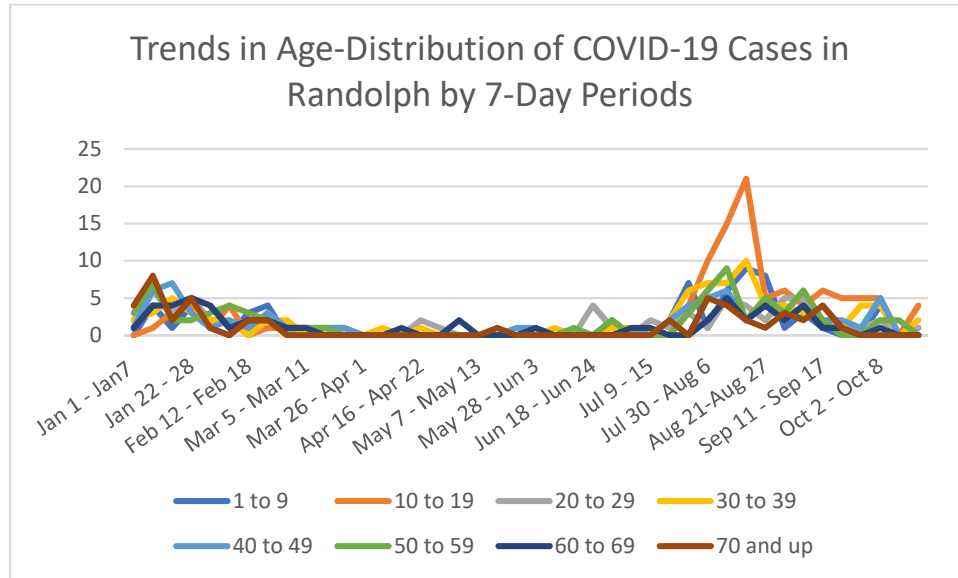

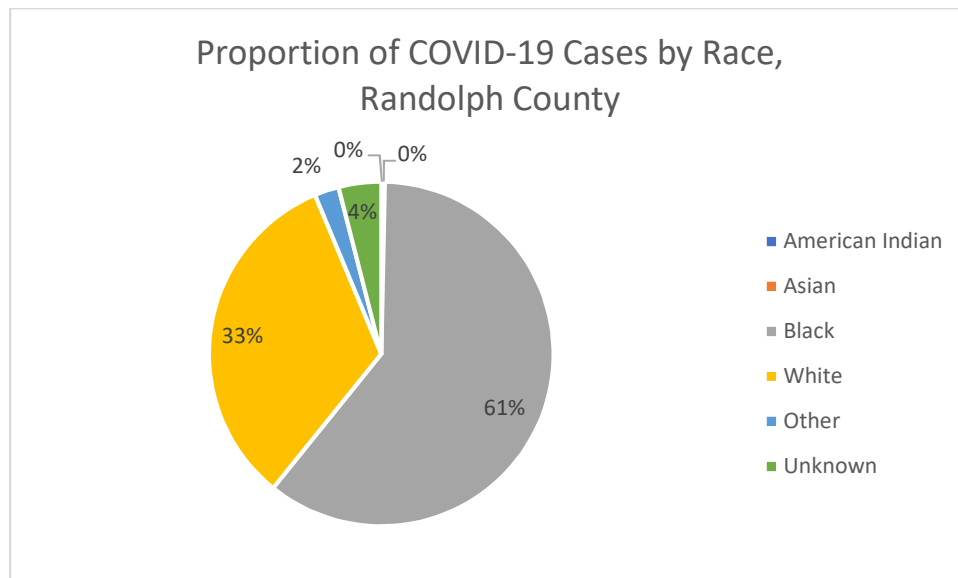

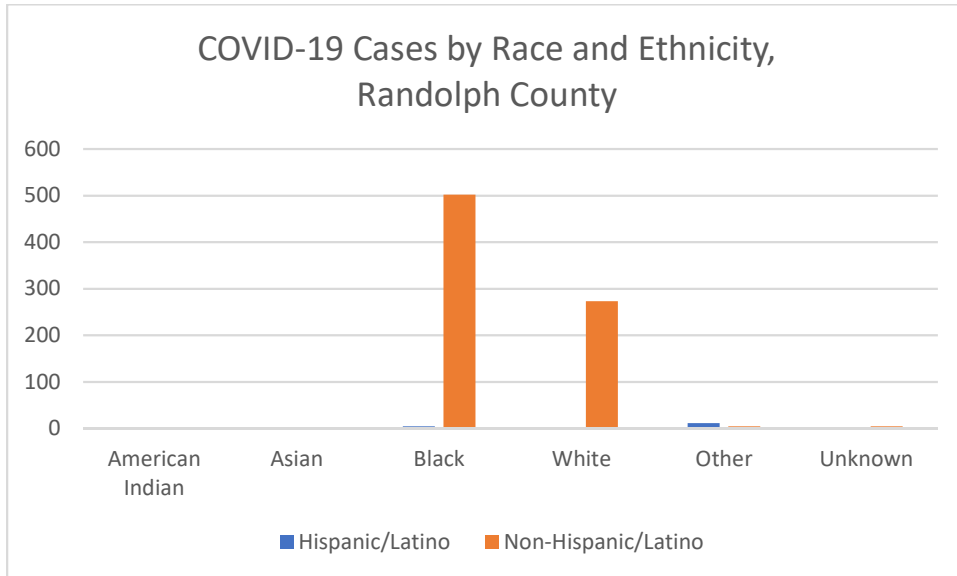
**GRAPH 1. DISTRIBUTION OF POSITIVE CASES BY AGE OVER 7-DAY PERIODS**



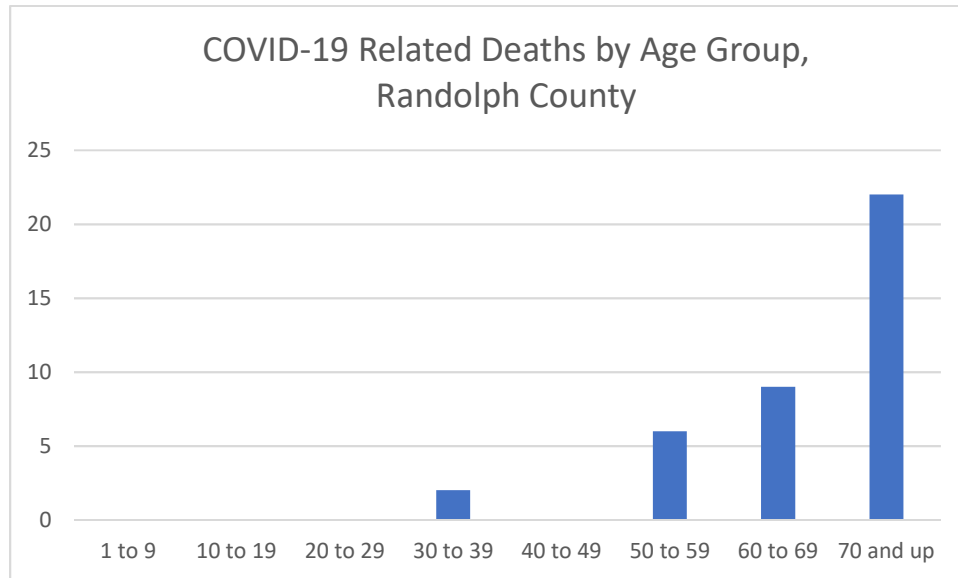
**GRAPH 2. PROPORTION OF COVID-19 CASES IN RANDOLPH COUNTY**



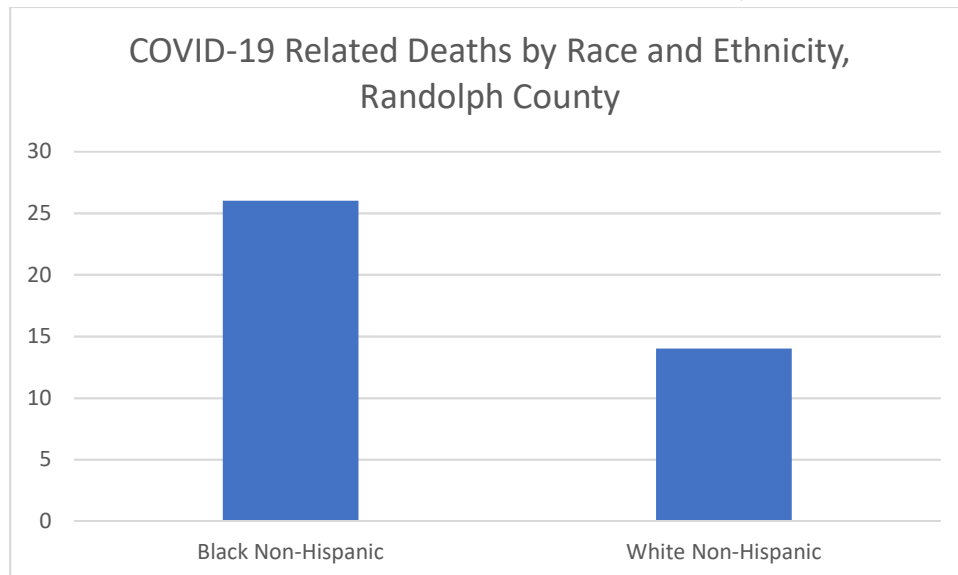
**GRAPH 3. COVID-19 CASES BY RACE AND ETHNICITY IN RANDOLPH COUNTY**
