

## COVID-19 SUMMARY REPORT FOR SUMTER COUNTY

- As of October 25, 2021, Sumter County has 4,119 cases of COVID-19 and 129 confirmed deaths
- There were 34 cases reported in Sumter County from October 8 to October 14
- Sumter County accounts for 0.3% of the cases in Georgia
- 8.7% of the positive cases in Sumter County have been hospitalized and 3.1% have died
- The average percent of positive PCR tests in Sumter County over the last 7 days is 6.8%
- The total number of confirmed cases (PCR) per 100,000 people in Sumter County is 9,306.44
- In Sumter County, 15,777 residents (52%) have received at least one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine and 14,373 (48%) have been fully vaccinated

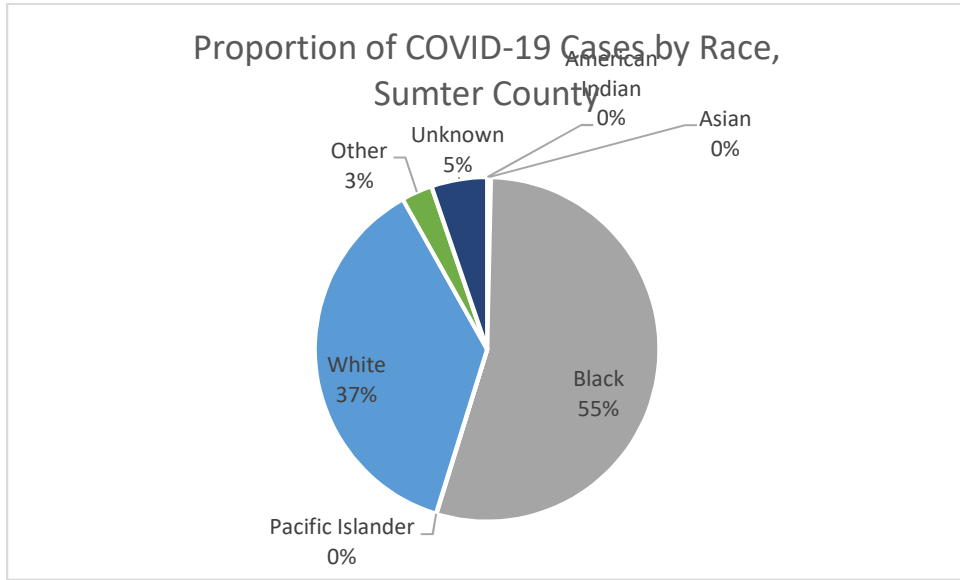

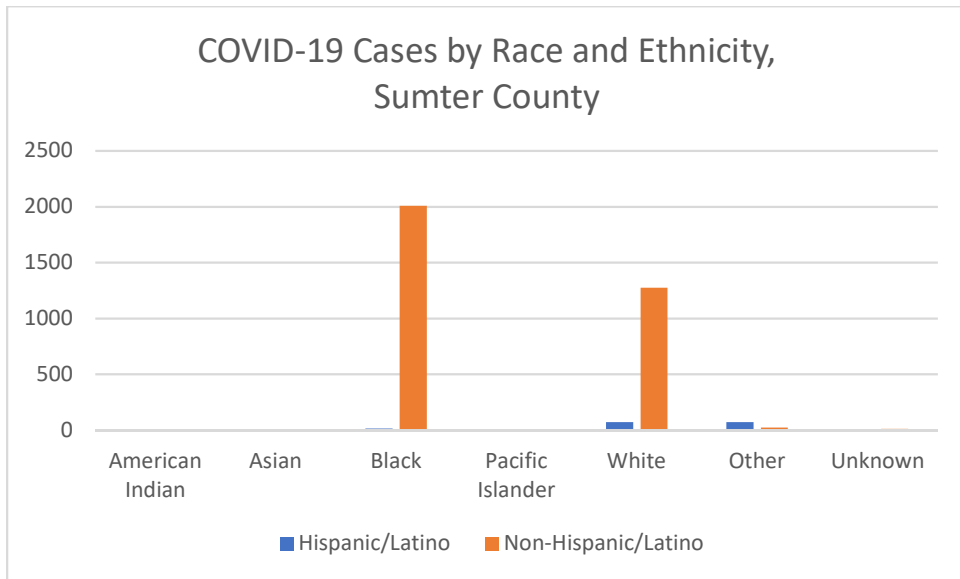

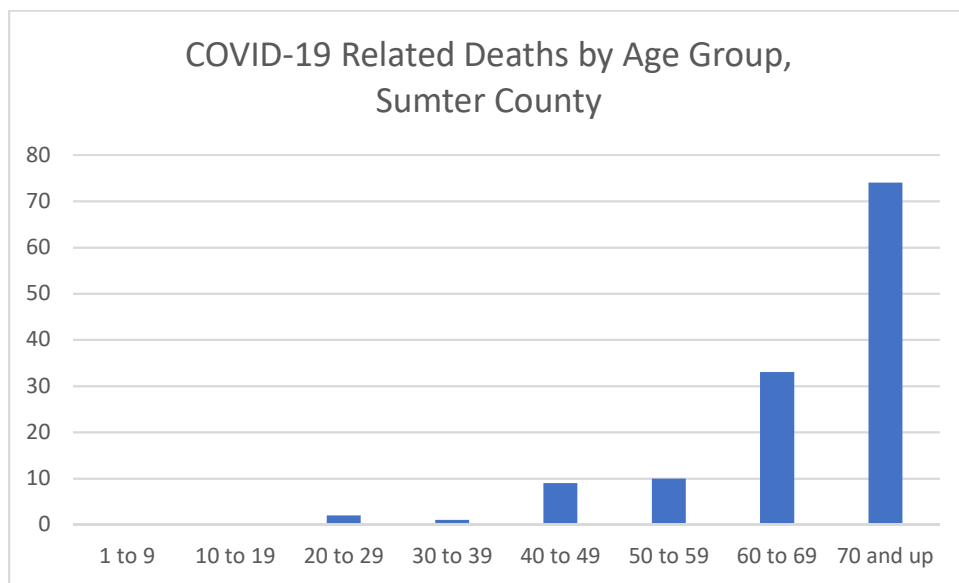
**GRAPH 2. PROPORTION OF COVID-19 CASES IN SUMTER COUNTY**



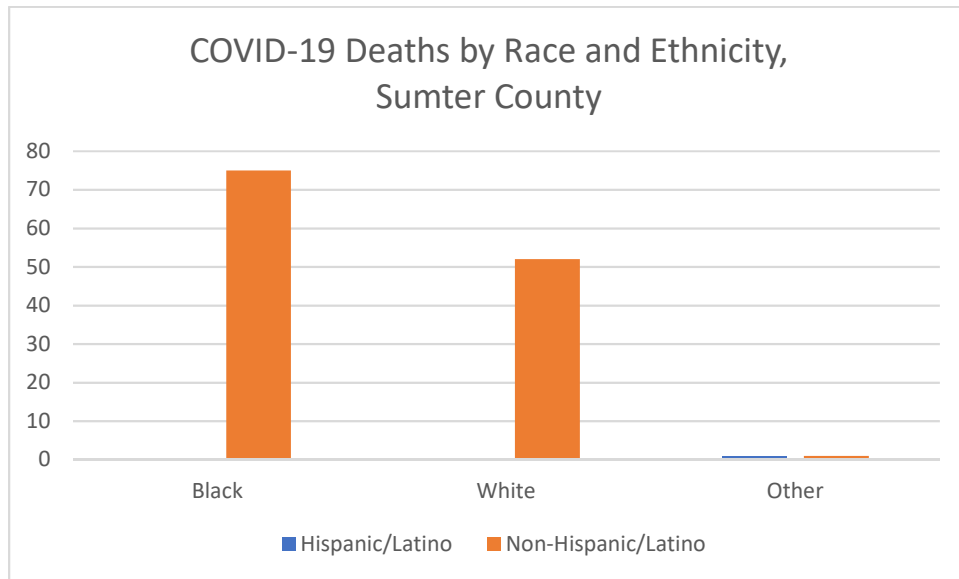
**GRAPH 3. PROPORTION OF COVID-19 CASES BY RACE AND ETHNICITY IN SUMTER COUNTY**
