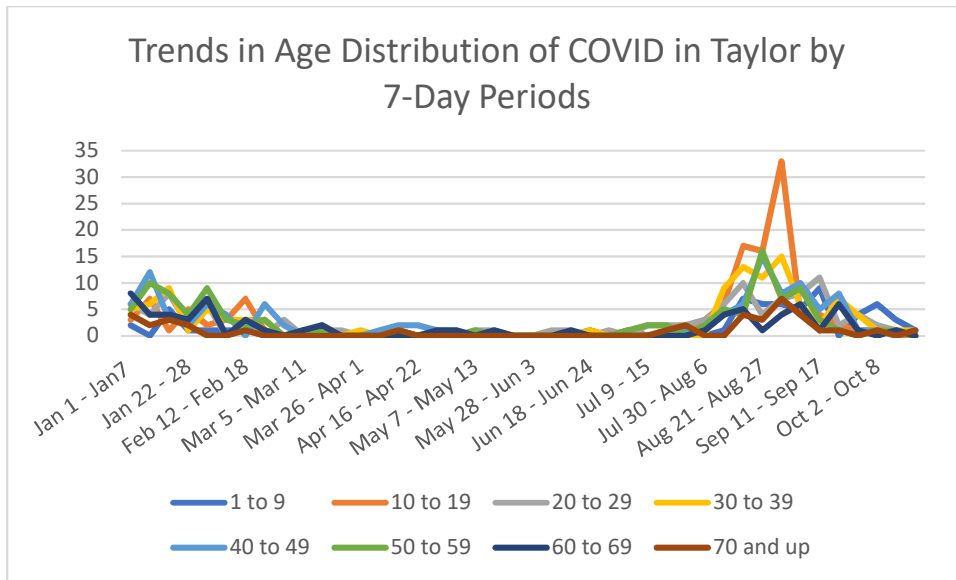

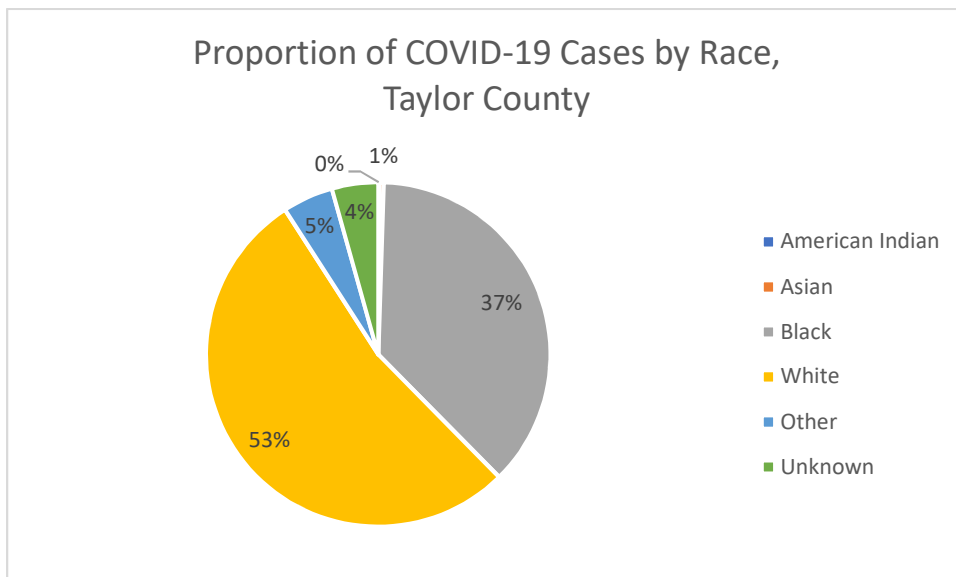

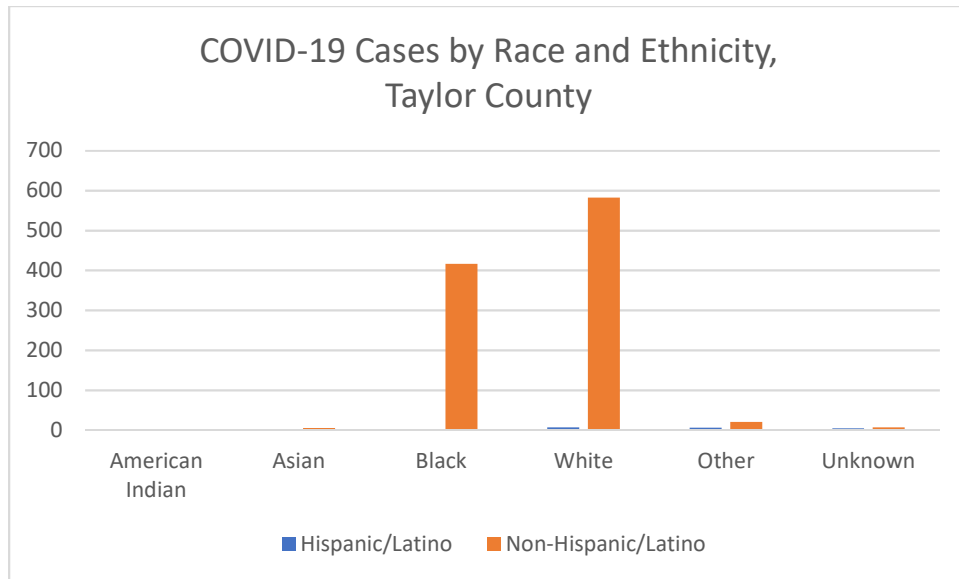
GRAPH 1. DISTRIBUTION OF POSITIVE CASES BY AGE OVER 7-DAY PERIOD



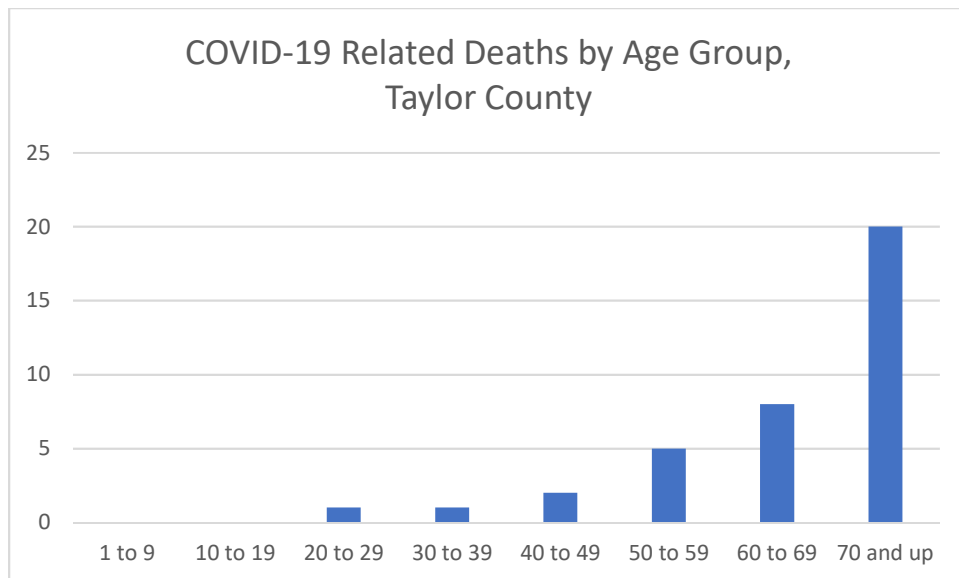
GRAPH 2. PROPORTION OF COVID-19 CASES IN TAYLOR COUNTY

GRAPH 5. PROPORTION OF COVID-19 RELATED DEATHS BY RACE AND ETHNICITY IN TAYLOR COUNTY

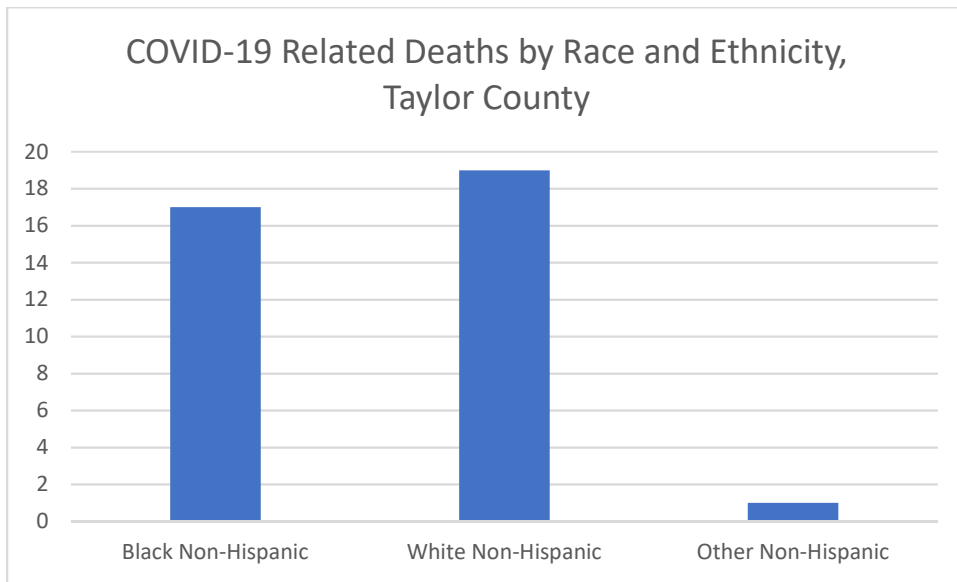
