Unintentional Injuries
60% due to fall; rates 1.4X higher in females than in males; rates 1.6X higher in black females than in black males



Bone & Muscle Diseases

Rates 1.4X higher in female than in males; rates 1.9X higher in black than in white



Digestive System Diseases

Rates 1.9X higher in females than in males; rates 2X higher in white female than in white males
