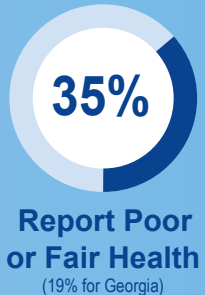

Approximately 41% of Stewart County residents are obese compared to 33% of Georgia residents.



24% of adults currently smoke in Stewart County, while 17% of adults currently smoke in Georgia.



The percentage of alcohol impaired driving deaths is 29% in Stewart County compared to 21% in Georgia



The unemployment rate in Stewart County is 22.5%, whereas in Georgia it is 3.4%.
